NEW MEMBER APPLICATION

We welcome new members who want to join our club. The safe handling of firearms is the number one priority. Unsafe handling of firearms and deliberate destruction of club property will not be tolerated and could lead to immediate expulsion from the club.

We require all new members to take the club orientation course. This takes about 1 ½ hours and is currently scheduled on Saturday afternoons. Your membership will not become effective until the course is completed and your membership fees are received. Your membership renews annually by **October 31** no matter what time of year you join the club. Payments can be made by cash, cheque or EMT.

Our club is affiliated with the CCFR. They are a Canadian Gun Rights Organization. They provide our individual member liability insurance. Membership in the CCFR is included in your OSC membership fee. You can renew your CCFR membership on your own or through another organization that you belong to.

To book a place for the next orientation, contact Mike Boyle by text (preferably) at 519-701-2022.

It is preferred that your first membership payment be made on the date you complete your orientation at the club. EMT (Electronic Money Transfer) email address is oxfordsportsmanclub@gmail.com and the security code is **trapshooting**. Make sure that you enter your **name** in the message box, so the proper person is credited. Payment can also be made with cash or cheque at the club when the clubhouse is open.

OSC RANGE RULES

Trap Range Rules

- 1 Guns are to remain open at all times except on firing Line or in gun rack.
- 2 Eye and ear protection must be worn.
- 3 Only one shell at a time in gun except when shooting doubles.
- 4 Do not close action until it is your turn to shoot.
- 5 NO ammunition larger than 12gauge 3 1/2 dram or shot larger than # 7 1/2
- 6 When changing stations on trap line guns must be open and unloaded.
- 7 When someone down range or the red flag is up on the trap house; all guns are to be open and unloaded, until the person down range or red flag on trap house is taken down.
- 8 Trap range and Rifle range will be closed on those days scheduled for sporting clays shoot and will remain close until the sporting clays event is over

Sporting Clays

- 1 Sporting Clays will operate under the same rules as Trap
- 2 Trap and Rifle range will be closed until after the sporting event is finished

Rifle Range

Only one firearm can be live at a time on the entire range. Shoot only targets that are directly in front of the bench that you are shooting from.

- 1 Red flag must be raised on the pole near the 100-yard shooting bench.
- 2 All shooters must sign in log book located at the flag pole, name or number, guest included.
- 3 Eye and ear protection must be worn.
- 4 Shooting alone is not recommended.
- 5 Someone must act as range officer.
- 6 Firearms unloaded and actions open and no handling of firearms when anyone is down range.
- 7 Targets are to be positioned on target board so no shots will hit any part of the wood frame.
- 8 No steel or exploding targets are to be used on the range.
- 9 No shot gun target load pattering to be done on the range.
- 10 No shooting after dark.
- 11 No Restricted firearms to be used on range or property.
- 12 Members must closely supervise all guests and minors.
- 13 Clean up shell casings and removed targets when finished shooting and lower flag.
- 14 No shooting further back than the 100-yard bench.
- 15 Rifle and Trap ranges will be closed during a Sporting Clays event.

Shotgun Patterning Board

- 1 Clay target loads ONLY
- 2 No rifle, slugs, buckshot or hunting loads
- 3 Shoot from the 20, 30 or 40 yard markers.
- 4 Point of Aim should be in line with the blue arrows.
